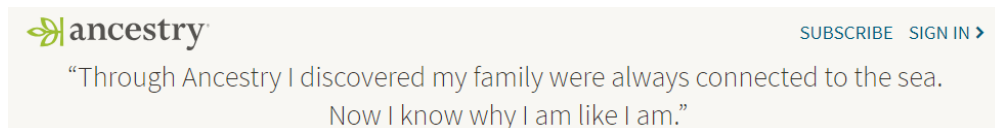




Comparing the Big 4 subscription sites

Ancestry, Findmypast and MyHeritage are three of the largest genealogy subscription sites. FamilySearch is free to use.

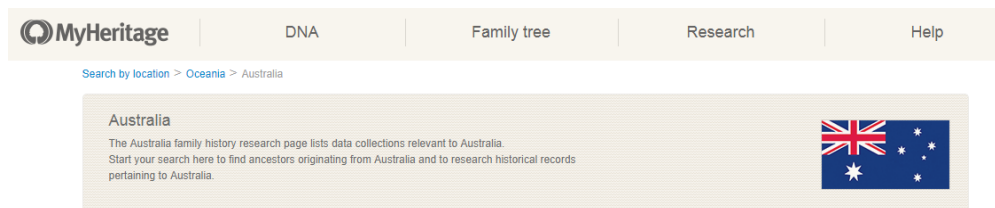
Before taking the leap to subscribe to any of the sites, work out what records you need, the historical periods you are interested in, and the locations you are researching, and then check each site to see whether they hold the record types you will need. 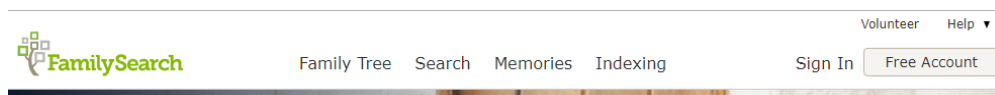
Ancestry – search.ancestry.com > Explore by Location > click a place
