All Other Records

Over 500,000 records transcribed from the Adelaide City Citizens Rolls 1852-1910.

These electoral rolls list those who can vote in Adelaide City municipal elections, which apply to the city square mile and North Adelaide. To qualify citizens had to either own or occupy property within the City.

Data available:

- Location the street name
- Event Date year of the collected data
- Ward geographical area
- Property type of property eg land, dwelling, house, shop, etc.
- No. of Acre precursor to street numbers

The Ward, Property and Acre can be found in the Notes field. The geographical boundaries of Wards have changed over time. Refer City of Adelaide's, History of the City Wards, Source Sheet No. 57 for more information.

Searching tip: search by name and sort results by the year of the event and/or location. This will then give a chronological list of the changes made at the address over the years.

Some of the entries are from the Supplementary List, which may include those added after the roll closed.



Hospital Admissions

Over 23,000 new Hospital Admissions for:

- Adelaide/RAH covering years 1925-27, and
- Parkside Lunatic Asylum, years 1918-1921 (previously embargoed)

Each record describes an admission to a hospital, asylum or lying-in homes (including a petition for entry for lunatic asylums).

The Adelaide (later Royal Adelaide) Hospital admission records often recorded the name of the ship the patient arrived on, and also how long they have been in South Australia. Other Hospitals spasmodically did the same.

Schools

Added over 8,000 records for 10 new schools as follows:

- Alma South
- Blair Athol Primary Girls
- Beltana Rural
- Charlton
- Cockburn Rural
- Coromandel Valley
- Mylor Primary
- · Victor Harbor Higher Primary later District High
- Wanilla (extension)
- Woodville Spastic Centre Special School

Generally each record shows the registration pupil in a school, and usually includes parents and dates, although there are exceptions. Includes some Sunday schools and teacher/headmaster rolls.

Parish Marriages

Added marriage records for St Philips Anglican for the years 1964-2008.

The name of the parish or church may not be the same as its name when the marriage occurred, due to changes over the years. Similarly, the religious denomination of a parish/church may also have changed (from Methodist to Uniting for example).

- Anniversaries 2012-2018
- Changes: 4 individual feedback notifications
