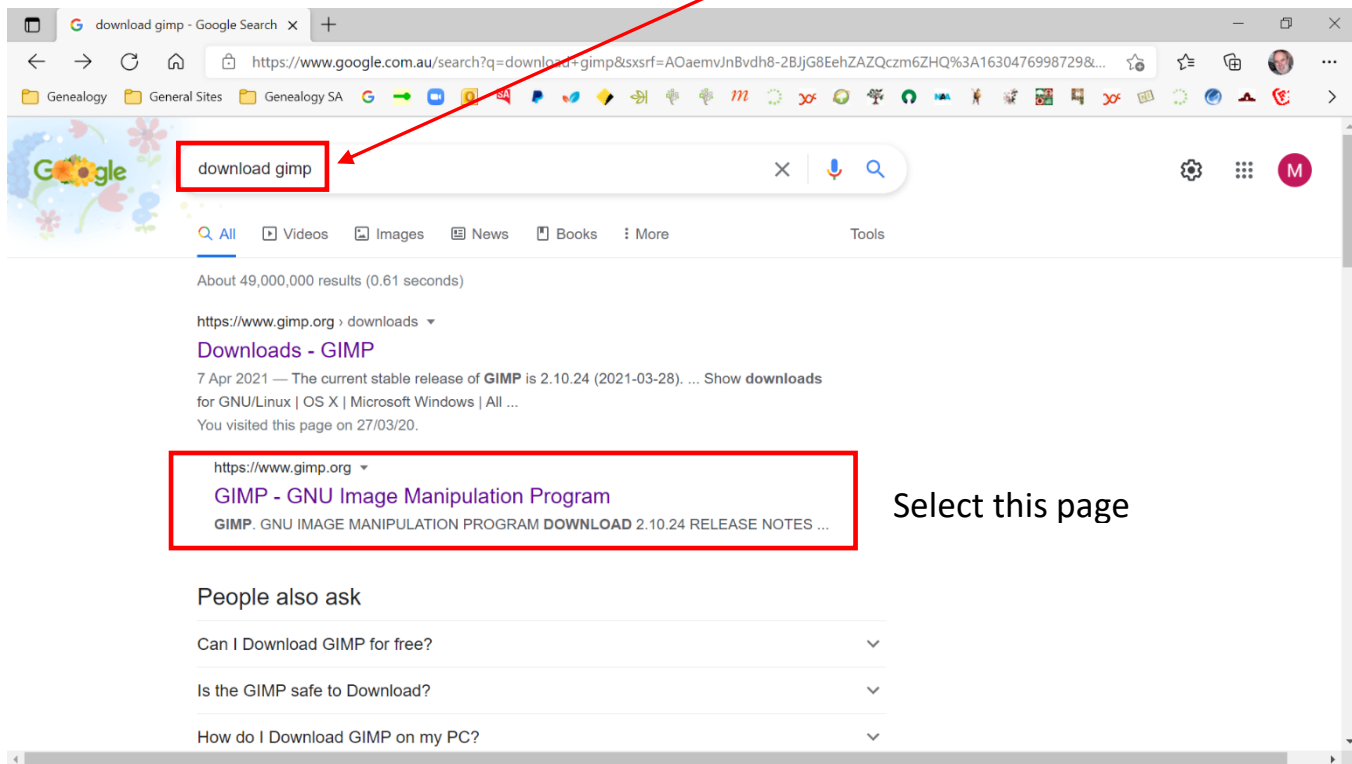

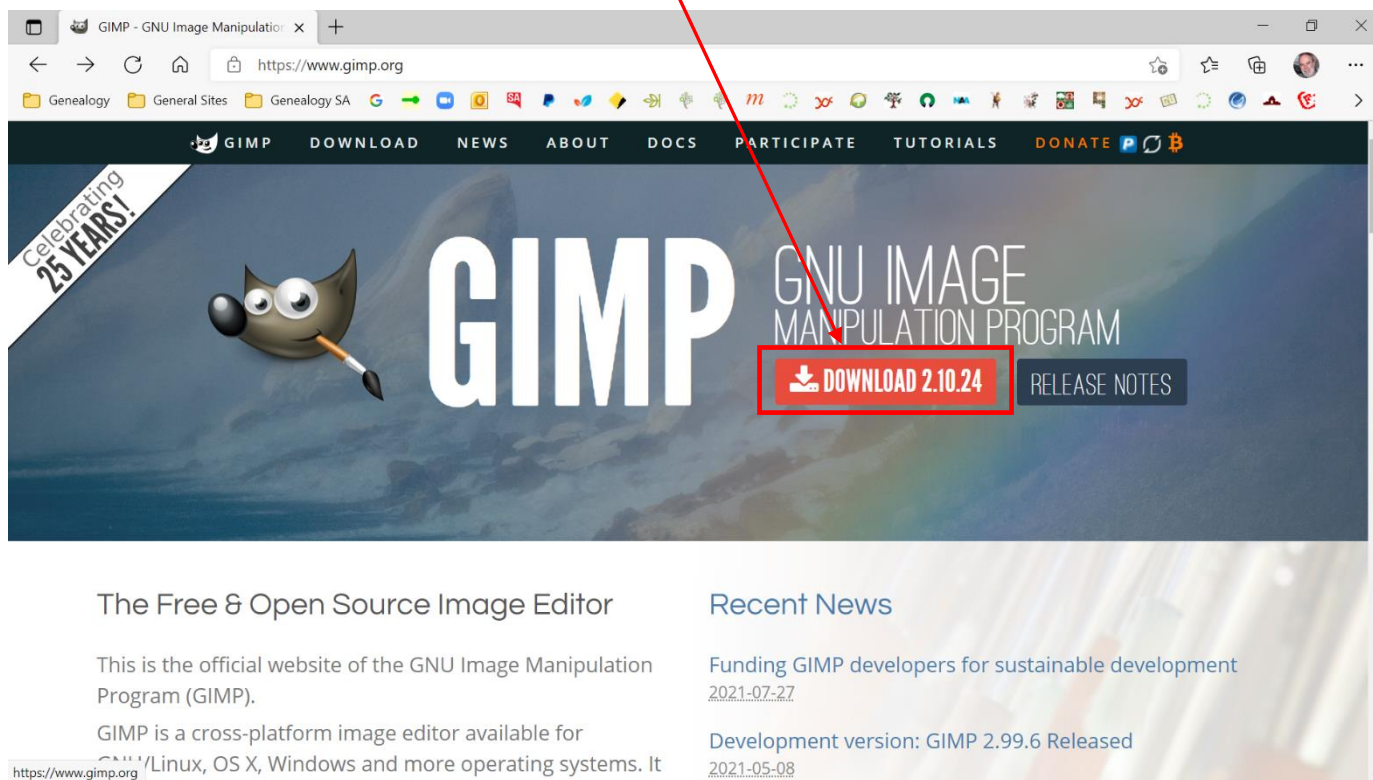
## How to Install GIMP

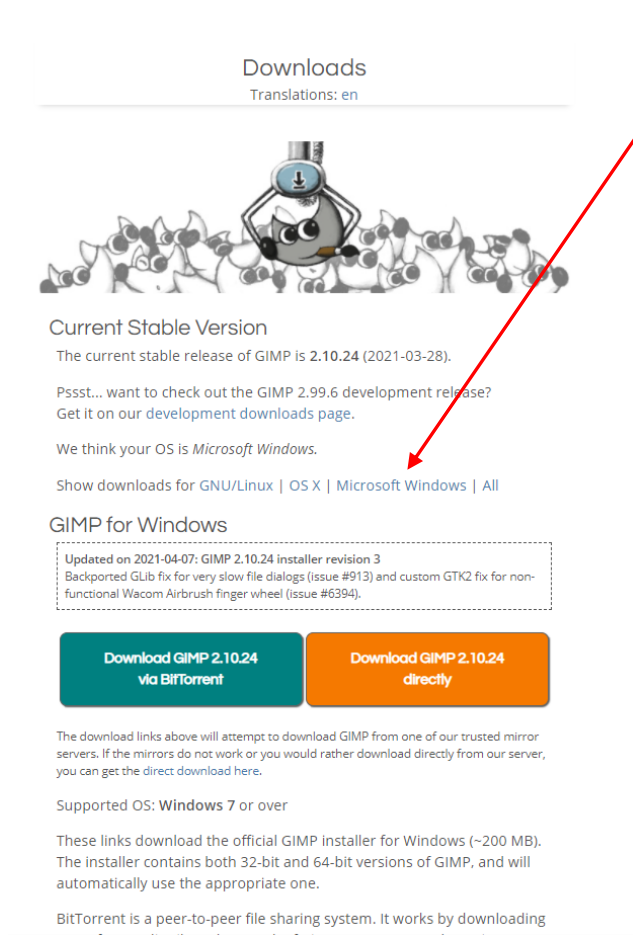

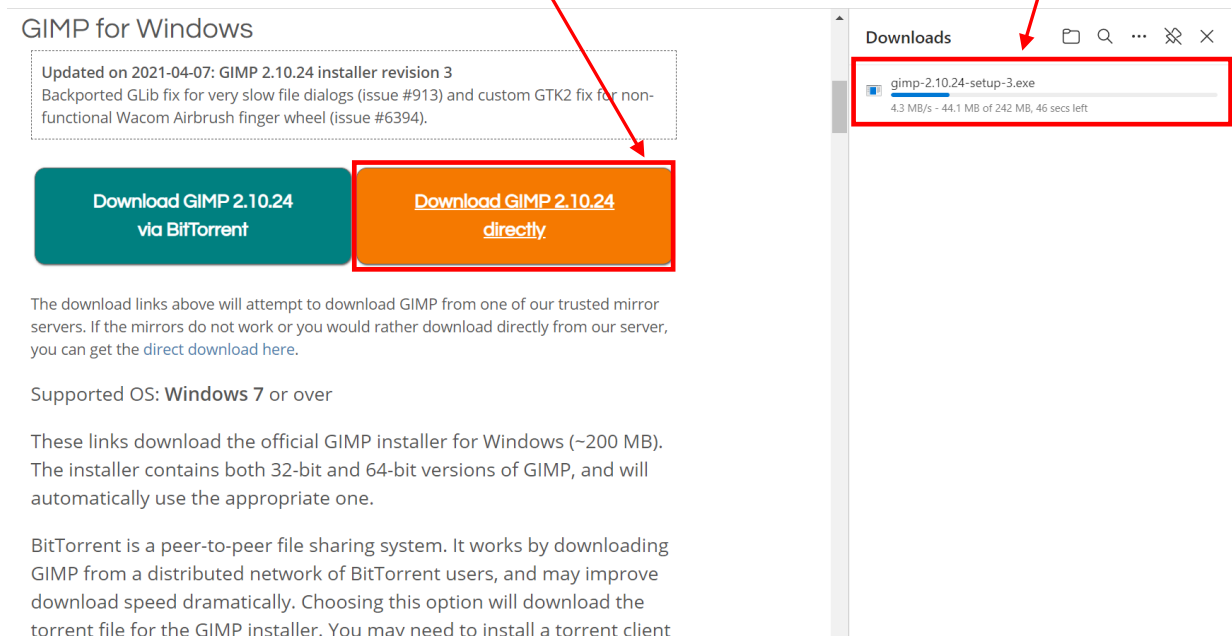

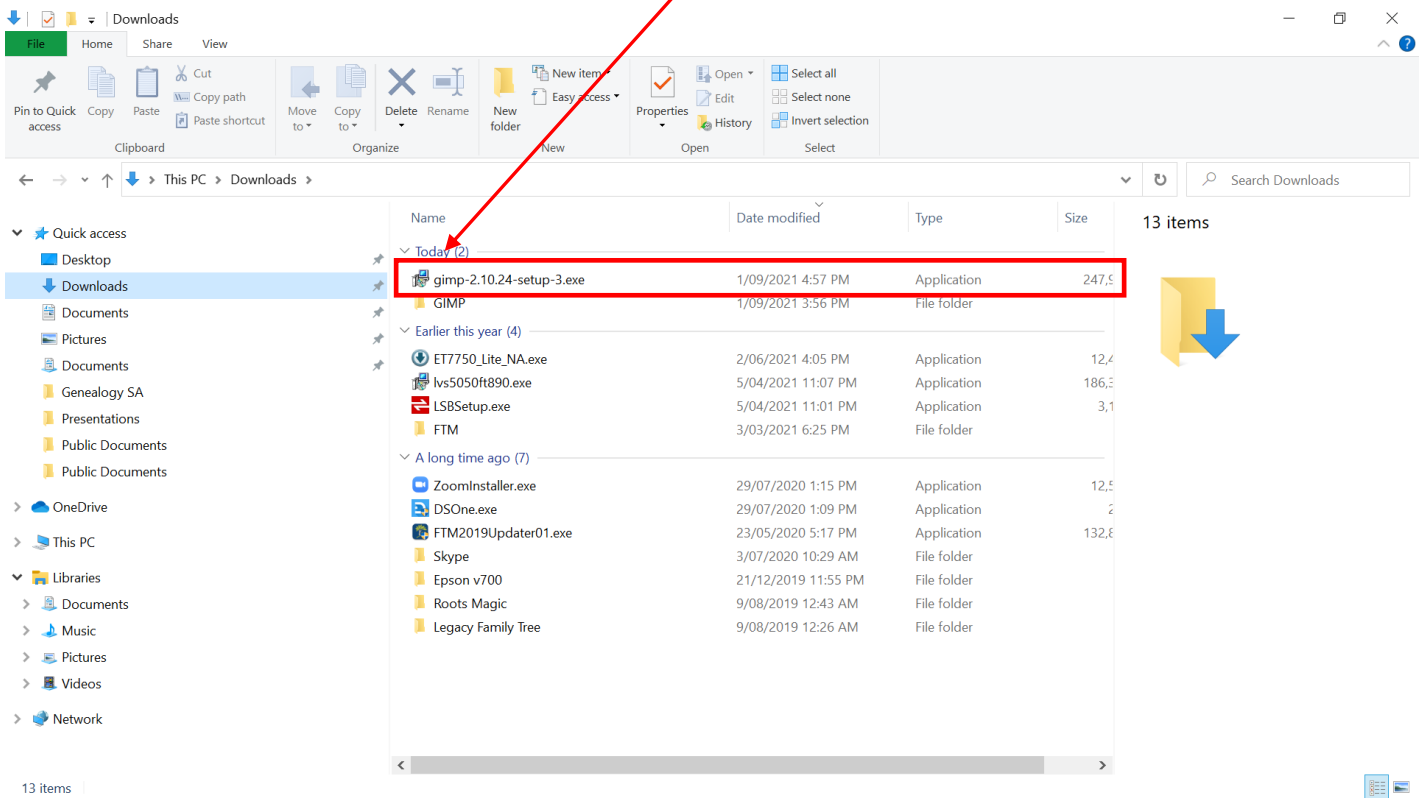
On the Downloads page click on the operating system you run, e.g. **“Microsoft Windows”**



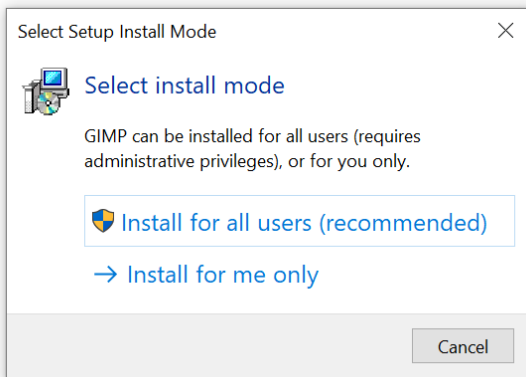

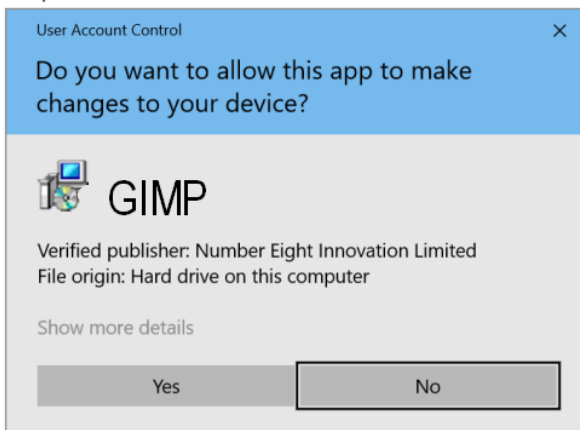
Open the downloads folder and double click on “gimp-2.10.24-setup” and GIMP will start the install process.



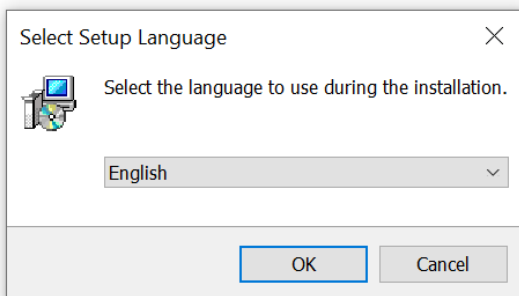
Click on “Install for all users (recommended)”



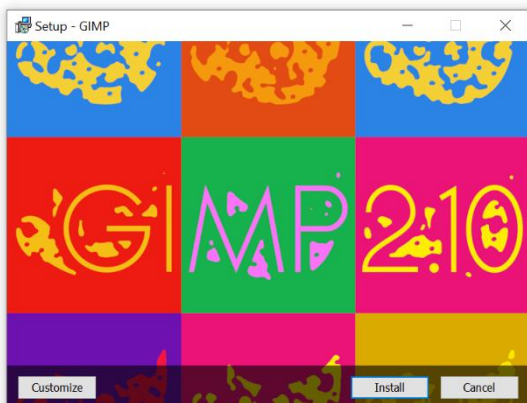
Click on “Yes”



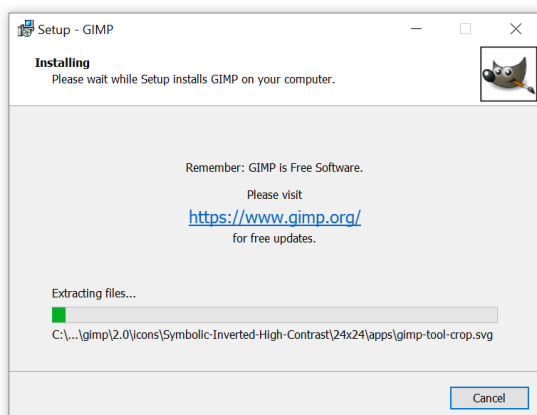
Select **“English”** and click on **“OK”**



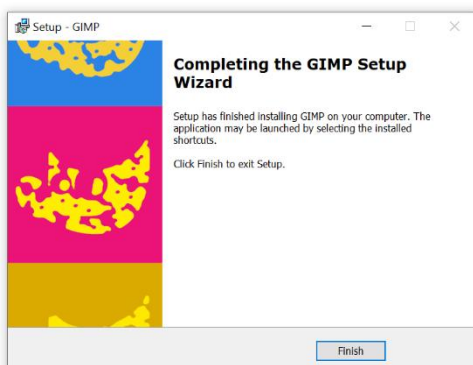
Click on **“Install”**.
